ALL BIKES MUST HAVE A YELLOW REGISTRATION PLATE AFFIXED VERTICALLY TO THE REAR OF THE MACHINE OR HELMET AT ALL TIMES & YOUR NUMBERED BIB MUST BE VISABLE TO FRONT AND REAR.

Teams: To consist of 3 riders, any club each riding a different route £15 per team, cash only at signing on.

Section Flag/Route descriptions:

A ROUTE (EXPERT) - FOLLOW RED FLAGS NO DEVIATION

B+ ROUTE (CLUBMAN/EXPERT) – TO FOLLOW RED FLAGS ONLY DEVIATING WITH BLUE FLAGS B+ ROUTE (CLUBMAN/EXPERT) – ON SECTIONS INDICATED WITH B+ BOARD TO FOLLOW RED FLAGS ONLY DEVIATING WITH PURPLE FLAGS

B ROUTE (CLUBMAN) - TO FOLLOW RED FLAGS ONLY DEVIATING WITH BLUE FLAGS

C+ ROUTE (NOVICE/CLUBMAN) - TO FOLLOW RED FLAGS DEVIATING WITH BLUE & YELLOW FLAGS C+ ROUTE (NOVICE/CLUBMAN) - ON SECTIONS INDICATED WITH A C+ BOARD TO FOLLOW RED FLAGS DEVIATING WITH BLUE & GREEN FLAGS

C ROUTE (NOVICE) - TO FOLLOW RED FLAGS DEVIATING WITH BLUE & YELLOW FLAGS



Saturday 8th November (Day1)

Pits & sign on for riders starts at **07:45** until **09:00** at **Carré Farm La route des Vinchelez**, St Ouen (what 3 words. ///Loudness. Probable. Herald).

Please confirm your start time, start group and enter your team at the yellow club van when signing on **Riders Briefing will be 09:15 in the pits.**

START:

Officials will start the trial in groups from 09:30 you will **NOT** be able to start the event after your due start unless permission has been sought from C Of C prior to this.

You will have <u>6hrs</u> to complete 3 laps of 15 sections from the time you start. Observers will close sections at 15:40 sharp, no exceptions, no arguments please. Unless you have been deemed retired, then for any uncompleted sections you will be awarded 5 marks per section.

FINISH:

Once finished please sign off at the yellow club van and keep your riding bib safe overnight. Lost bibs will be charged at £50 each. OBSERVERS

Please be aware an **Observer is a judge of fact** and as such it is only, they who can amend a scoresheet with the C of C permission, their decision is final should there be any discrepancies over marking and any protests over scores you will need to follow the correct ACU procedure TSR.39.

Observers will be using a whistle to signal when they are ready for you to enter their section, then and only then may you start, observers will mark a 5 if you start before they are ready.

It goes without saying that we treat the observers with the utmost respect, they give up their time for free so please be respectful if you feel the need to question their scoring and remember they are there for your enjoyment, make them feel they are valued.

If you are aware of anyone that retires during the event, please ensure you advise the Clerk of the Course/ course marshals/sweeper riders/ observers as you go round, please.

ROUTE

Please follow the correct route between sections, cutting the course or "Doubling up" on groups of sections will not be tolerated, you will be excluded, no exceptions.

This is a STOP ALLOWED trial as per ACU TSR22

FIRST AID

First aid kits are available for self-administration at the start of each venue.



Sunday 9th November (Day 2)

Pits open from 7.45am at **Acorn Enterprises**, La Rue au Seller, Trinity.

Parking is tight so please arrive in plenty of time and park neatly.

Competitors do not need to sign on again but please check your start time/start group at the yellow club van.

START:

The Clerk of the Course will then start the trial in groups at 9.30am after a two-minute silence in respect of Remembrance Day.

You will <u>NOT</u> be able to start the event after you are due unless permission has been sought from C Of C prior to this.

You will have 6hrs to complete 3 laps of 15 sections from the time you start.

Observers will close sections at 15:40 sharp, no exceptions, no arguments please. Unless you have been deemed retired, then for any uncompleted sections you will be awarded 5 marks per section.

FINISH:

When you have finished, please return to the club van and hand your bib back to the official in the yellow club van. You will be given your finishers award.
